Message from Inspector Selvarajah

My team have been very busy dealing with weather related issues over the last few days. This meant that we had to cancel our street briefings. New dates will be announced so please come along and let us know your views. Our 4x4 very came into its own allowing us to still be able to respond and help those in need. The main issues to report upon are those in Diss Town Centre.

We have responded to numerous reports of anti- social behaviour linked to homelessness, begging, busking and consuming alcohol in public. My team have responded to these reports and taken positive action where the law allows. I am confident that a sense of normality has returned to the town after some interventions by police and our partners. We have received some reports of anti-social behaviour in Long Stratton and the beat manager is now dealing with this.

Crime Updates

Offence	Numbers	What could this entail
Arson	0	Damage caused as a result of fire.
Anti-Social Behaviour (ASB)	0	Harassment, alarm or distress is caused in a non-crime incident.
Burglary - Business and community	0	Thefts committed in shops, businesses and other property
Burglary - Residential	1	Entry to any building within the curtilage/boundary of a residence, e.g. garden sheds and garages
Criminal Damage	1	A person destroys or damages property belonging to someone else.
Domestic	1	Domestic incidents where a crime has not occurred. Parties are aged 16 or over and have been intimate partners or family members regardless of sexuality.
Hate Incident	0	Any incident where a crime has not occurred which the victim, or anyone else, thinks is based on someone's prejudice towards them because of their race, religion, sexual orientation, disability or because they are transgender.
Race or Religious aggravated public fear	0	Any crime determined to have a hate element as per above.
Possession of controlled substance	0	Unlawful possession of a drug classified in class A, B or C.
Possession of weapons	0	Unlawful possession of an article used as a weapon.
Public fear, alarm or distress	0	Public order offences e.g. from a verbal altercation to offences just short of violence.
Robbery	0	Includes a range of offences where force is used, threatened or the victim is put in fear.
Theft from a motor vehicle	1	Any item stolen that was in, on or attached to a motor vehicle.
Theft or unauthorised taking of a motor vehicle	0	Any motor vehicle including those abandoned.
Theft of pedal cycle	0	From a public place, if stolen from a shed or garage this would be a BOTD.
Theft from a person	0	Purse being taken from a handbag, or a mobile phone from a shopping basket.

Diss Safer Neighbourhood Team have continued to conduct plain clothes patrols around the night-time economy, and acting on intelligence received.

Recent anti-social behaviour in Diss has led to a number of arrests and progress is beginning on long term solutions. Foot patrols continue in Diss and the surrounding area.
