Message from Inspector Selvarajah

Locally we have had reports of tools being stolen from vehicles, sheds and outbuildings. This follows a regional trend and I ask that you remain vigilant and report suspicious activity. My team have made some good pro-active arrests for vehicle related crime and recently executed a drugs warrant at Pulham Market. Road safety remains a priority and speed checks have been carried out across the area. Three vehicles were seized in Diss within the space of two hours. The beat manager team have been looking at developing intelligence around drug activity and enforcement will follow.

Crime Updates

Offence	Numbers	What could this entail
Arson	0	Damage caused as a result of fire.
Anti-Social Behaviour (ASB)	0	Harassment, alarm or distress is caused in a non-crime incident.
Burglary - Business and community	0	Thefts committed in shops, businesses and other property
Burglary - Residential	0	Entry to any building within the curtilage/boundary of a residence, e.g. garden sheds and garages
Criminal Damage	0	A person destroys or damages property belonging to someone else.
Domestic	1	Domestic incidents where a crime has not occurred. Parties are aged 16 or over and have been intimate partners or family members regardless of sexuality.
Hate Incident	0	Any incident where a crime has not occurred which the victim, or anyone else, thinks is based on someone's prejudice towards them because of their race, religion, sexual orientation, disability or because they are transgender.
Race or Religious aggravated public fear	0	Any crime determined to have a hate element as per above.
Possession of controlled substance	0	Unlawful possession of a drug classified in class A, B or C.
Possession of weapons	0	Unlawful possession of an article used as a weapon.
Public fear, alarm or distress	0	Public order offences e.g. from a verbal altercation to offences just short of violence.
Robbery	0	Includes a range of offences where force is used, threatened or the victim is put in fear.
Theft from a motor vehicle	0	Any item stolen that was in, on or attached to a motor vehicle.
Theft or unauthorised taking of a motor vehicle	0	Any motor vehicle including those abandoned.
Theft of pedal cycle	0	From a public place, if stolen from a shed or garage this would be a BOTD.
Theft from a person	0	Purse being taken from a handbag, or a mobile phone from a shopping basket.

Patrols have been conducted around the area concentrating on rural crime. We have been responding to reports of Hare coursing, suspicious vehicles, this has including crossing the border and assisting Suffolk.

A Misuse of Drugs Act warrant has been conducted by the team this month which has led to the seizure of a quantity of Class B Drugs.

I have been liaising with South Norfolk Council Licencing Team and attended the 'Pubwatch' meeting. This has resulted with 1 banning letter being issued. This ban has banned a person from one licenced premises indefinitely and all others members premises for 6 months.
