Message from Inspector Selvarajah

We have held our quarterly street surgeries across Diss, Harleston and Long Stratton policing areas. Speeding, vehicle related anti- social behaviour and drugs appear to be consistent concerns across the whole area. As the summer arrives and the visitors numbers increase our demand profile changes. There are more emergency and priority incidents to attend which means we must deploy our resources effectively. My team use their downtime to tackle the issues raised during our street surgeries. I hope you can join us in Harleston on 11th July so my team and I can update you on the work we have been doing.

Crime Updates

Offence	Numbers	What could this entail
Arson	1	Damage caused as a result of fire.
Anti-Social Behaviour (ASB)	0	Harassment, alarm or distress is caused in a non-crime incident.
Burglary - Business and community	0	Thefts committed in shops, businesses and other property
Burglary - Residential	0	Entry to any building within the curtilage/boundary of a residence, e.g. garden sheds and garages
Criminal Damage	1	A person destroys or damages property belonging to someone else.
Domestic	2	Domestic incidents where a crime has not occurred. Parties are aged 16 or over and have been intimate partners or family members regardless of sexuality.
Hate Incident	0	Any incident where a crime has not occurred which the victim, or anyone else, thinks is based on someone's prejudice towards them because of their race, religion, sexual orientation, disability or because they are transgender.
Race or Religious aggravated public fear	0	Any crime determined to have a hate element as per above.
Possession of controlled substance	0	Unlawful possession of a drug classified in class A, B or C.
Possession of weapons	0	Unlawful possession of an article used as a weapon.
Public fear, alarm or distress	1	Public order offences e.g. from a verbal altercation to offences just short of violence.
Robbery	0	Includes a range of offences where force is used, threatened or the victim is put in fear.
Theft from a motor vehicle	0	Any item stolen that was in, on or attached to a motor vehicle.
Theft or unauthorised taking of a motor vehicle	0	Any motor vehicle including those abandoned.
Theft of pedal cycle	0	From a public place, if stolen from a shed or garage this would be a BOTD.
Theft from a person	0	Purse being taken from a handbag, or a mobile phone from a shopping basket.

Diss Safer Neighbourhood Team have conducted the Diss Street surgery, this has set the priorities for the next three months as dealing with Speeding, Anti-social use of motor vehicles and issues with drug use.
